Specific legislation

Procedures of entities operating in energy

- **Directive 2004/17/EC** coordinating the procurement procedures of entities in water, energy, transport and postal services sectors
- **Directive 92/13/EC** coordinating the laws, regulations and administrative provisions relating to the application of Community rules on the procurement procedures of entities operating in water, energy, transport and telecommunications sectors.
- **Directive 93/38/EC** coordinating the procurement procedures of entities operating in the water, energy, transport and telecommunications sectors



Specific legislation

Procedures concerning the award of public contracts

-Directive 89/665/EEC of 21 December 1989 on the coordination of the laws, regulations and administrative provisions relating to the application of review procedures to the award of public supply and public works contracts.

-Directive 2007/66/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 December 2007 amending Council Directives **89/665/EEC** and **92/13/EEC** with regard to improving the effectiveness of review procedures concerning the award of public contracts



Specific legislation

Licences to explore and the exploitation of the minewater

- **Directive 2000/60/EC** of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 October 2000 establishing a framework for Community action in the field of water policy.
- **Directive 2006/118/EC** of the European Parliament and of the Council of 12 December 2006 on the protection of groundwater against pollution and deterioration.



POLICY AREAS

-**Decision of 30 June 2009** establishing a template for National Renewable Energy Action Plans under Directive 2009/28/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council
